ALTERATIONS TO STATUTES

TO CORRECT MISTAKES, INACCURCIES, INCONSISTENCIES AND INFELICITIES

I. STATUTE of the General Synod of the Church of Ireland, Chapter 1 of 1999. (concerning the Revised Common Lectionary as adapted for use in the Church of Ireland)

1. In the INTRODUCTION TO THE LECTIONARY

- (i) In section 1 thereof in paragraph 3 for the words "marked in the schedule as" wherever they occur there shall be substituted the words "indicated as".
- (ii) In section 1 thereof in paragraph 4 the words "Where the principal service..." to "also be accommodated" shall be deleted and for the word "portions" there shall be substituted the word "readings".
- (iii) In section 2 thereof in paragraph 1 for the words from "The Church of Ireland Liturgical Committee..." to "Revised Common Lectionary" there shall be substituted the words "In this table some passages are included which differ from its provisions".
- (iv) In section 4 thereof for the words "are the work of the Consultation" there shall be substituted the words "was prepared by the Liturgical Advisory Committee in co-operation with the Church of England Liturgical Commission".
- (v) In the section BIBLE VERSIONS THE TEXTS the paragraph beginning "Versification of the Psalms" shall be deleted.
- The Schedule shall be amended by including the alterations and additions to citations for readings as set out in the appended TABLE OF AMENDMENTS TO TABLE OF READINGS – WEEK-DAY FESTIVALS and SUNDAYS.

II. STATUTE of the General Synod of the Church of Ireland Chapter 1 of 2000. (concerning Morning and Evening Prayer in traditional language)

- (i) In the Schedule to Chapter 1 of 2000, for the heading "Morning Prayer Daily throughout the year" there shall be substituted "Morning and Evening Prayer Daily throughout the year".
- (ii) After the words: "the Lord"s Name be praised" there shall be inserted the rubric "At Evening Prayer turn to page 000" and then shall be inserted before "VENITE" the heading "At Morning Prayer".
- (iii) At the end of "JUBILATE" there shall be inserted a rubric "At Morning Prayer turn to page 000" and after that rubric a heading, "At Evening Prayer".

 There shall then be inserted that whole section from Evening Prayer beginning with "THE PSALM or PSALMS" and concluding with "DEUS MISEREATUR, Psalm 67".
- (iv) Immediately before the heading "The Apostles' Creed" there shall be inserted "At Morning and Evening Prayer".
- (v) After the words "THE COLLECT OF THE DAY" there shall be inserted the heading "At Morning Prayer".
- (vi) At the end of the Third Collect there shall be inserted the heading "At Evening Prayer" followed by the second and third collects of Evening Prayer, followed by "At Morning and Evening Prayer".
- (vii) The whole of the remainder of Evening Prayer as printed in the Schedule shall be deleted.
- (viii) For the words:

"R.I. [O Lord, save the President".

there shall be substituted

"R.I. [O Lord, guide and defend our rulers."

III. STATUTE of the General Synod of the Church of Ireland, Chapter 2 of 2000. (concerning Morning and Evening Prayer in contemporary language)

- (i) In the Schedule to Chapter 2 of 2000 the heading "MORNING PRAYER" shall be deleted.
- (ii) All the marginal section numbers shall be deleted.
- (iii) In the heading "PROCLAIMING AND RECEIVING THE WORD OF GOD" the words "OF GOD" shall be deleted.
- (iv) Before the words "O Lord, open our lips" there shall be inserted the words "At Evening Prayer turn to page 000" and immediately thereafter a heading "At Morning Prayer" shall be inserted.

(v)

- (vi) After the section headed "The Sermon" and the rubric "A hymn may be sung "the following rubric shall be inserted "Continue on page 000 with the Apostles' Creed" and then the heading "At Evening Prayer"
 - There shall then be inserted that whole section from Evening Prayer beginning with "O Lord, open our lips" and concluding with "THE SERMON etc and A hymn may be sung".
- (vii) After the words "One of more of these collects:" there shall be added the heading "At Morning Prayer"
 - At the end of the collect beginning "Heavenly Father, in whom..." the heading "At Evening Prayer" shall be inserted followed by the three collects from Evening Prayer.
- (vii) The whole of the remainder of Evening Prayer as printed in the said Schedule shall be deleted.
- (viii) In the rubric after the Second Reading the words "and sections 11 and 12 are omitted" shall be deleted
- (ix) For the words "in section ZZ" wherever they are found there shall be substituted the words "pages 000-000".

IV. STATUTE of the General Synod of the Church of Ireland Chapter 2 of 2001. (concerning Holy Communion in contemporary language)

- (i) In the paragraph headed "THE COMMUNION" after the words "and died for you" the words "and lives for you" shall be deleted.
- (ii) In the paragraph headed "DISMISSAL" for the words "among you" there shall be substituted the words "with you".
- (iii) In the Appendix Part B SEASONAL VARIATIONS in the paragraph headed "Transfiguration" for the words "establish, strengthen and settle you in the faith" there shall be substituted the words "support, strengthen and establish you in the faith".

V. STATUTE of the General Synod of the Church of Ireland, Chapter 5 of 2002 (concerning Funeral Services)

For the Notes in "A Form for use at the Burial of Ashes after Cremation" there shall be substituted the following:

Note: In the case of the committal of ashes on land or at sea the Guidelines of the House of Bishops currently in force should be followed.
