Friday	Saviour of the World (page 00).
Saturday	The Song of Wisdom (page 00).

ONE OR TWO READINGS, *the second from the New Testament*

THE GOSPEL CANTICLE : Benedictus (page00)

THE APOSTLES' CREED *may be said.*

*This reflects the way the Church structure's its common prayer and may be a basis for personal or family devotions*

**Preparation**

A SENTENCE OF SCRIPTURE (page 00)

A PRAYER OF PENITENCE

*That on page 00 may be used, or one of the penitential kyries ( pages 00-00).*

PRAISE

'Glory be ...' on page 00

or 'Holy, holy..' on page 00 *may be used.*

**The Word of God**

A PSALM

*The canticles Venite (page 00) or Jubilate (page 00) may be used instead.*

A BIBLE READING

A CANTICLE

*Any of those on pages 00-00 may be used.*

**Prayer**

INTERCESSIONS AND THANKSGIVINGS

*Those on page 00 may be used.*

THE COLLECT OF THE DAY OR ANOTHER COLLECT

*The choice of psalm and reading may be from the table of weekday readings approved by the House of Bishops or from some other system of regular bible reading.*
